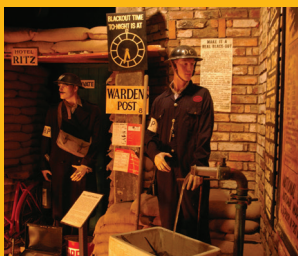

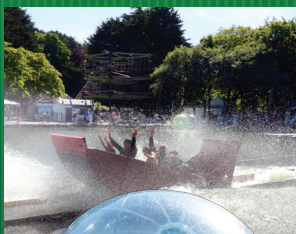

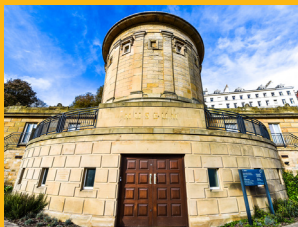

One of the UK's top wildlife spectacles – around half a million seabirds on towering cliffs. Puffins visit April to early August and thousands of the UK's largest seabird, the gannet, make their home here from March to late October. Cliff top viewing platforms (most with wheelchair access) give close-up views of the birds and panoramic views of the dramatic coast.

The Seabird Centre has information, live images from the nesting sites, gift shop, food and drink. Guided walks, nature trails plus Discovery Backpacks for kids. Seasonal events and activities throughout the year. RSPB Seabird Cruises sail from Bridlington in spring and summer.

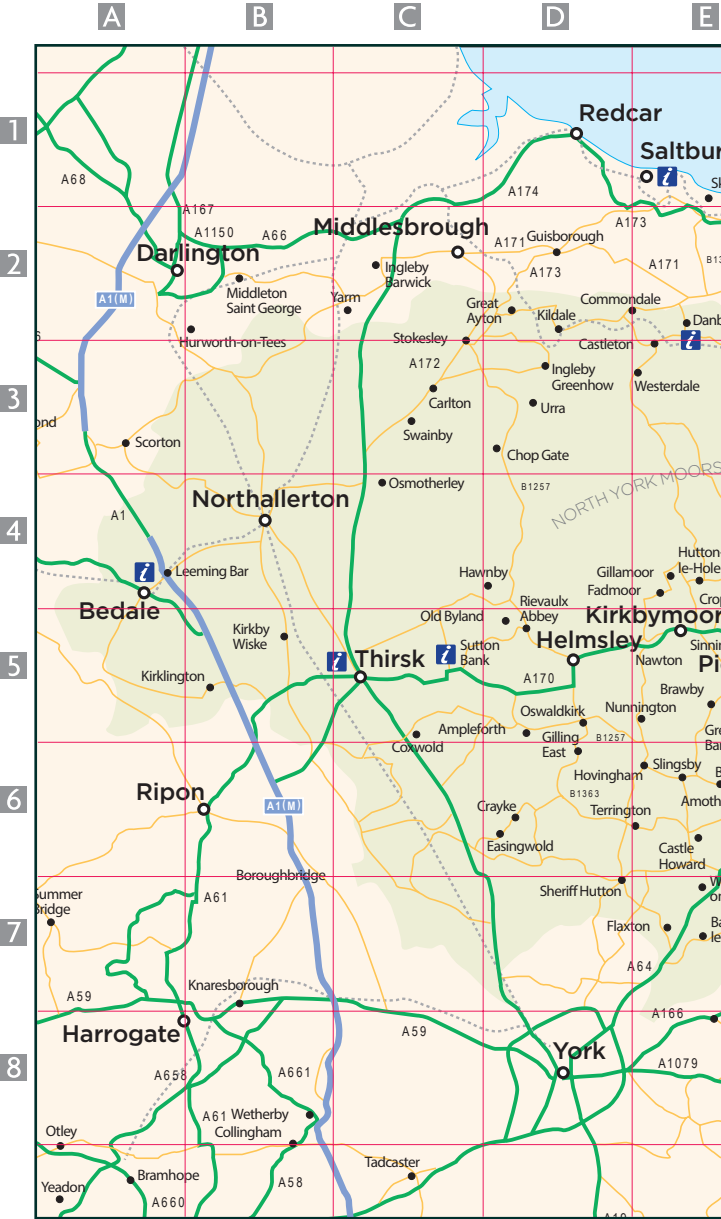

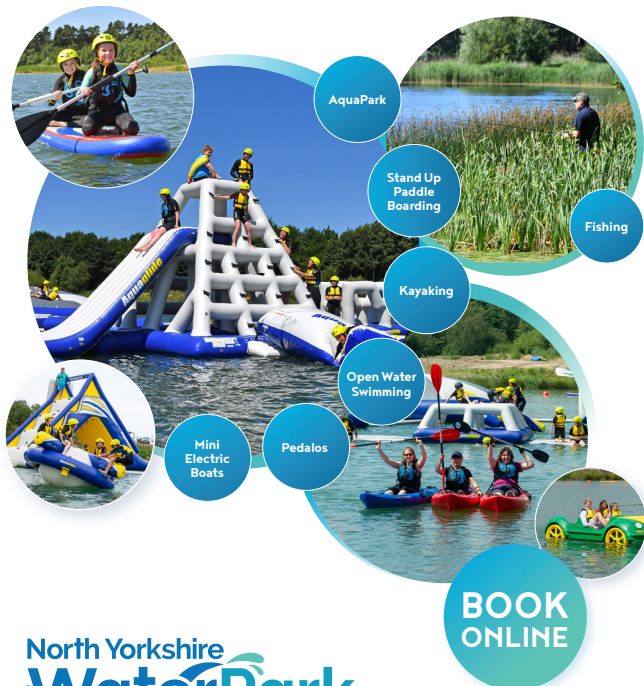
